Pick 15 words and do the following:

- Write your words 5 times each
- Write your words in ABC order
- Write your words. Circle the vowels and underline the consonants.
- Write your words and cross out all of the silent letters.
- Write your words in cursive
- Write words forwards and backwards
- Write your spelling words and add up each word. Consonants = 10 points, vowels = 5.  
**Example** CAT:  $10 + 5 + 10 = 25$
- Write your spelling words; then rewrite making all vowels lowercase and all consonants uppercase

## Desserts



Pick 15 words and do the following:

- Make a set of flashcards for your words
- Use scrabble tiles, alphabet pasta, cereal or magnetic letters to form your words
- Cut words out of a magazine and paste them on paper
- Read a newspaper, circle your spelling words
- Make your words using popsicle sticks, toothpicks or other material
- Write your words in pencil, then trace over with 2 different colors
- Write your spelling words in bubble letters
- Write your words in dots and then connect them.
